- Jeff Plymale (Huntington WV Housing Authority) Mr. Plymale informed us of
  the various housing programs they offer. A few of the programs are: Section 8
  Housing Program, Housing for Vets, Public Housing, a Resource Center at
  Marcum Terrace, a food box offered once/month for appx. 100 families, a
  clothing pantry, free tax preparation until April 15<sup>th</sup> for low income, a baby

- Melissa Bias thanked all of the vendors who attended/participated in our Resource Fair at our Cabell Huntington One-Stop building. It was a success!
- Melissa Bias announced and explained that the state has brought to our attention that "we need to show we are a proud partner of the American Job Center" on each flyer/brochure we create.

- Region 2 WIB is trying to develop Apprenticeship Programs for jobs for our youth in the month of May.
- Melissa Bias reported that appx. 35/40 youth we enrolled recently need a High School Diploma; Mingo County has the highest poverty rate in our 7 counties.

# **One-Stop Updates/Discussion:**

- Discussions were held deciding the location and times we could have more
  Resource Fairs. We discussed that the Resource Fairs help show our youth the
  reason why and how these resources will help them. Melissa Bias explained,
